10. What steps do you take to make sure the ground over which you must move or set up your equipment is stable enough for the weight of the equipment?

11. Do you ever act as a subcontractor to another contractor? If so, do you become a party to harmless agreements as part of the contract? Please attach copies of recent contracts you've signed (include at least one example of a contract containing a hold harmless agreement, if applicable).

20. Do you ever lease or loan equipment? If so, how often?
